1. Eligibility criteria for admission to Ph.D. program:

1.1 Candidates for admission to the Ph.D. program shall have a Master's degree in the concerned specialization or a professional degree in the concerned specialization declared equivalent to the Master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) or an equivalent degree from a foreign educational Institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country for the purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards or educational institutions.

1.2 A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC/NT (non-creamy layer/Differently abled and other categories) of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time, or for those who had obtained the Master's degree prior to 19th September, 1991. The eligibility marks of 55% (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible based only on the qualifying marks without including the grace marks.

2. Subject to the conditions stipulated in these Regulations, the following persons are eligible to seek admission to the Ph.D. program:

- 2.1 Master's Degree holders satisfying the criteria stipulated under Clause 1 above, and or
- 2.2 Candidates who have successfully completed the M.Phil. degree with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) shall be eligible for admission to the Ph.D. degree in the same faculty and specialization. A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC/NT (non-creamy layer/differently abled and other categories of candidates) as per the decision of the Commission from time to time.
- 2.3 Candidates possessing a Degree considered equivalent to M.Phil Degree of an Indian Institution from a Foreign Educational Institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country for the purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions, shall be eligible for admission to Ph.D. program.

3. Duration of the Program:

- 3.1 Ph.D. program shall be for a minimum duration of three years, including course work and a maximum of five years.
- 3.2 Extension beyond the above limits will be governed by the relevant clauses as stipulated in the Statute/Ordinance of the individual Institution concerned.

4. Procedure for admission:

- 4.1 University and Institution shall admit Ph.D. students through an Entrance Test conducted at the level of Individual University.
- 4.2 Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs) referred to in sub-clause 1.2 above and Colleges under them which are allowed to conduct M.Phil and/or Ph.D. programs, will :
 - 4.2.1 decide on an annual basis through their academic bodies a predetermined and manageable number of M.Phil. and/or Ph.D. scholars to be admitted depending on the number of available Research Supervisors and other academic and physical facilities available, keeping in mind the norms regarding the scholar-teacher ratio (as indicated in Para 5.5), laboratory, library and such other facilities:
 - 4.2.2 notify well in advance on the institutional website and through advertisement in at least two (2) national newspapers, of which at least one (1) shall be in the regional language, the number of seats for admission, subject/discipline-wise distribution of available seats, criteria for admission, procedure for admission, examination centre(s) where entrance test(s) shall be conducted and all other relevant information for the benefit of the candidates:
 - 4.2.3 Adhere to the National/State-level reservation policy, as applicable.
- 4.3 The admission will be based on the criteria notified by the Institution, keeping in view the guidelines/norms in this regard issued by the UGC and other statutory bodies concerned, and taking into account the reservation policy of the Central/State Government from time to time.

- 4.4 HEIs will admit candidates by a two-stage process:
- 4.4.1 Through an Entrance Test with qualifying marks as 50%. The syllabus of the Entrance Test shall consist of 50% of research Methodology and 50% of subject of specialization. The Entrance Test shall be conducted at the Centre(s) notified in advance (changes of Centres, if any, also to be notified well in advance) at the level of the individual HEI and
- 4.4.2 Through an interview/viva-voce, to be organized by the HEI as and where the candidates are required to discuss their research interest/area through a presentation before a duly constituted Department Research Committee.
- 4.5 The interview/viva voce shall also consider the following aspects, viz. whether:
- 4.5.1 the candidate possesses the competence for the proposed research:
- 4.5.2 the research work can be suitably undertaken at the Institution/College:
- 4.5.3 the proposed area of research can contribute to new/additional knowledge.
- 4.6 For the purpose of the Merit List for admission to Ph.D. 70% weightage will be given for PET/ Post Graduate score in the concerned specialization (whichever may be higher will be considered) and 30% weightage shall be given for viva-voce score as mentioned in clause 4.5.
- For securing the admission Ph.D. course the student must secure minimum 55% marks in the viva-voce examination.
- A relaxation of 5% of marks in viva-voce examination from 55% to 50%, will be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC/NT (non-creamy layer/Differently abled and other categories) of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time
- 4.6.1 Seniority in age of applicant students will be considered as preference while preparing the merit list of student's faculty/specialization wise.

NOTE:

- I) A candidate shall have to work in a recognized place of research such as University Departments and other Research Institutes recognized by the University as a Center of Research.
- II) Every applicant from outside the State of Maharashtra but presently living in the State of Maharashtra shall have to submit an affidavit on stamp paper of Rs 100/- about his/her residence stating that he/she is residing in state of Maharashtra from last six months.
- III) The applicant should fill up all the forms for appearing in the P.E.T., 2020 examination. Incomplete form in any respect will be rejected and no correspondence in this respect will be made.

5) **Exemption from entrance examination**

The University will exempt those students from Ph.D. Entrance Test who qualify UGC-NET (including JRF/UGC-CSIR NET (including JRF/SLET/GATE/teacher fellowship holder or have passed M.Phil program or submitted the M.Phil. thesis but viva-voce is pending.

The students with Ph.D. qualification in any discipline shall be exempted from Ph.D. Entrance Test for obtaining admission to Ph.D. course in another specialization in which he/she has Master's Degree as specified in clause two (2) above.

Those candidates eligible for exemption for the PET must submit the exemption form.

6) **P.E.T. (Ph.D. Degree Entrance Test)**

a) The application form for PET and exemption form is available on the University website www.kksanskrituni.digitaluniversity.ac.

b) There shall be one paper of 100 marks, Concerned Subject and Research Methodology.

1. CONCERNED SUBJECT (50 MARKS) - Overall Passing Marks Minimum 50%

2. RESEARCH METHODOLOGY (50 MARKS) -

c) **P.E.T. being one of the eligibility criteria for Ph.D. Registration, the declaration of the candidate to be successful in P.E.T. shall not guarantee his/her registration for Ph.D. degree.**

d) **The PET score shall remain valid for a period of one year from the date of declaration of result.**

e) The University shall be the authority for calling the application forms from the candidates desirous to appear for P.E.T. for admission to Ph.D. degree. The application form for P.E.T. is available only on University Website www.kksanskrituni.digitaluniversity.ac.

f) All the filled in application forms along with attested copies of certificates and three self addressed envelopes (size 9" x 4") each affixed with stamps of Rs. 45/- with prescribed fee in cash or in the form of **Demand Draft** drawn in favour of "**Registrar, Kavikulaguru Kalidas Sanskrit University, Ramtek**" payable at Nagpur shall be received in **office of the Controller of Examination at Kavikulaguru Kalidas Sanskrit University, Prashkiya Bhavan, Mauda Road, Ramtek Dist. Nagpur-441106 Maharashtra.**

After scrutiny, the Examination department of the University shall publish the list of eligible candidates of P.E.T. along with roll numbers and provide admission card to all candidates within the prescribed period on the University website www.kksanskrituni.digitaluniversity.ac. The candidate should regularly visit the website to see the information uploaded on the website.

g) The P.E.T. shall be based upon the paper pattern as decided by the authorities.

Marathi/Hindi and English medium for rest of the subjects.

h) In case of any grievance of any candidate with respect to the conduct of Entrance Test the P.E.T. examination committee shall be competent authority to decide the dispute.

i) **In no case, examination fees will be refunded.**

Inter-disciplinary Research:

A candidate who is willing to take up research in a subject other than the one chosen for Post-Graduate Degree and/or in a subject, which is of inter-disciplinary nature like Ayurveda, Yoga, Astronomy, linguistics and so on, shall also be eligible for registration. The candidates with P.G. Degree in modern sciences, engineering and arts subjects and are willing to pursue their research in Interdisciplinary field involving Sanskrit, are also eligible provided they exhibit their knowledge of Sanskrit Language through any kind of evidence viz., their study of Sanskrit language as a part in their degree level or in any P.G. diploma or diploma or equivalent course offered by any university.

- a) The candidate shall be eligible for registration provided the research topic and the proposal are recommended by the faculty of the subject/ discipline wherein he/she wants to work for Doctoral Degree. In this case, the Degree shall be awarded in the subject/discipline of the Faculty in which he/she has applied/registered for Ph.D. work. Further, if the Research Supervisor requires, a co-supervisor from another discipline (i.e., the subject chosen by the candidate at his/her Master's Degree) may be taken.

Note: Separate *Sanskrit-aptitude* test will be conducted for students under this inter-disciplinary category.

- b) If the candidate wants to pursue the Ph.D. Degree in the subject/ discipline other than the one which he/she has chosen for P.G. Degree, then a special Board comprising of the subject experts of both or multiple discipline shall examine the proposal under the chairmanship of the Dean of concerned faculty. Further, the Degree shall be awarded in the subject/ discipline of the faculty in which the research scholar will be registered.

Issued under section 14(8) of the Kavikulaguru Kalidas Sanskrit Vishwavidyalaya (University) University Act, (Mah. XXXIII of 1997)

WHEREAS,

Kavikulaguru Kalidas Sanskrit University Act has come into force with effect from 1997.

AND

WHEREAS, the Dean, faculty of **Veda - Vidya** (Vedic Studies), **Sanskrit tatha Sanskritetara Bhasha**

(Sanskrit and languages other than Sanskrit), **Bhartiya Dharma, Tattvadnyana tatha Sanskriti** (Indian Religion, Philosophy and Culture), **Prachina Bhartiya Vidnyana tatha Manavyashastre** (Ancient Indian Sciences and Humanities) and **Shikshanashastra tatha Sankirna Vidyashakha** (Education and Other branches of learning) consented to these rules and the scheme of examination for the award of **Doctor of Philosophy (Ph. D.)** Degree.

AND

WHEREAS, the Vice-Chancellor, Kavikulaguru Kalidas Sanskrit University, Ramtek approved the recommendations so made by the Deans, required under section 14(1) of the act.

AND

WHEREAS, it is expedient to provide an Ordinance for the purpose of prescribing revised scheme of examination.

AND

WHEREAS, there is no Ordinance in existence and framing of an Ordinance for the above examination is a time-consuming process.

Direction Number 01 OF 2018 to provide for **Eligibility Criteria and procedure for Admission and Registration of Candidates, Selection of Guides and Research topics, Thesis submission and its Evaluation** for the degree of **Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.)** in the Faculty of **Veda - Vidya** (Vedic Studies), **Sanskrit tatha Sanskritetara Bhasha**(Sanskrit and languages other than Sanskrit), **Bhartiya Dharma, Tattvadnyana tatha Sanskrit**(Indian Religion, Philosophy and Culture), **Prachina Bhartiya Vidnyana tatha Manavyashastre** (Ancient Indian Sciences and Humanities) and **Shikshanashastra tatha Sankirna Vidyashakha** (Education and Other branches of learning)

(I) This Direction may be called "**Direction Number 01 OF 2018, Direction leading to the Degree of Doctor of Philosophy (Ph. D)**".

(II) This direction shall come into force with effect from the date of its issuance.

(III) Eligibility:

Subject to the conditions stipulated in this Direction, the following persons are eligible to seek admission to the Ph. D. Programme.

- 1) Master degree with at least 55 % marks in aggregate equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale or an equivalent degree from a foreign educational institution recognized or authorized by an authority established or incorporated under a law in its home country.
- 2) A relaxation of 5 % marks from 55 to 50 or an equivalent relaxation of grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)/ Differently abled and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the commission from time to time or for those who had obtained their master degree prior to 19th September 1991. The eligibility marks of 55 % and relaxation of 5 % to the categories mentioned above are permissible based only on the qualifying marks without including the grace marks procedures.
- 3) Candidates who have cleared the M. Phil. course work with at least 55 % marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC7-point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and successfully completing the M. Phil. Degree shall be eligible to proceed to do research work leading to the Ph. D. Degree in the same institution in an integrated program. The university may consider the reserved seats for M.Phil. pass out. A relaxation of 5 % mark from 55 to 50 or an equivalent relaxation of grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC/ (Non -Creamy Layer) differently- abide persons.
- 4) A person whose M. Phil. dissertation has been evaluated and the Viva-Voce is pending may be admitted to the Ph. D. programme of the same Institution.
- 5) Candidate possessing a Degree considered equivalent to M. Phil Degree of an Indian Institution from a foreign educational institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved recognized or authorized by an authority established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country for the purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions shall be eligible for admission to Ph. D. Programme.

(IV) PET (Ph.D. Entrance Test):

The PET (Ph.D. Entrance Test) of the University is compulsory for all students to get admission to the Ph.D. Programme. The PET shall be conducted by the University once in an academic year.

Eligibility: -Should have passed the PG examination or its equivalent in the relevant subject with minimum 55% of marks and above or its equivalent. (5% relaxation for reserved category)

Exemption: - As per the UGC Regulation 2016, exemption is granted to the following candidates from appearing in PET examination of University:

- 1) The candidate who qualify UGC/CSIR(JRF) Examination / SLET/ GATE/ Teacher fellowship.
- 2) The Candidate who have passed M. Phil. programme.

(V) Procedure for Admission:

University shall admit Ph. D. students who qualify PET examination of the University and those who have applied under exemption category as per the UGC Regulation 2016.

University including all departments shall decide on annual basis the manageable number of Ph. D. students to be admitted, depending on number of available Research Supervisors in the respective Department.

University shall notify well in advance in the institutional website and through advertisement in newspaper the number of seats for admission in subject/ discipline wise distribution of available seats criteria for admission procedure for admission examination centers where entrance tests shall be conducted and all other relevant information for the benefit of the candidates. The admission will be based on the criteria notified by the Institution, keeping in view the guidelines/norms in this regard issued by the UGC and other statutory bodies concerned, and taking into account the reservation policy of the Central/State Government from time to time.

HEIs will admit candidates by a two-stage process:

1 Through an Entrance Test with qualifying marks as 50%. The syllabus of the Entrance Test shall consist of 50% of research methodology and 50% of subject of specialization. The Entrance Test shall be conducted at the Centre(s) notified in advance (changes of Centre's, if any, also to be notified well in advance) at the level of the individual HEI and

2 Through an interview/viva-voce, to be organized by the HEI as and where the candidates are required to discuss their research interest/area through a presentation before a duly constituted Department Research Committee.

The interview/viva voce shall also consider the following aspects, viz. whether:

1. the candidate possesses the competence for the proposed research:
2. the research work can be suitably undertaken at the Institution/College:
3. the proposed area of research can contribute to new/additional knowledge.

For the purpose of the Merit List for admission to Ph.D. 50% weightage will be given for PET/ Post Graduate score in the concerned specialization (whichever may be higher, will be considered) and 50% weightage shall be given for viva-voce score. For securing the admission to Ph.D. course, the student must secure minimum 55% marks in the viva-voce examination. A relaxation of 5% of marks in viva-voce examination from 55% to 50%, will be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC/NT (non-creamy layer/ Differently abled and other categories) of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time

Seniority in age of applicant students will be considered as preference while preparing the merit list of student's faculty/specialization.

Inter-disciplinary Research:

A candidate who is willing to take up research in a subject other than the one chosen for Post-Graduate Degree and/or in a subject, which is of inter-disciplinary nature like Ayurveda, Yoga, Astronomy, linguistics and so on, shall also be eligible for registration. The candidates with P.G. Degree in modern sciences, engineering and arts subjects and are willing to pursue their research in Interdisciplinary field involving Sanskrit, are also eligible provided they exhibit their knowledge of Sanskrit Language through any kind of evidence viz., their study of Sanskrit language as a part in their degree level or in any P.G. diploma or diploma or equivalent course offered by any university.

- c) The candidate shall be eligible for registration provided the research topic and the proposal are recommended by the faculty of the subject/ discipline wherein he/she wants to work for Doctoral Degree. In this case, the Degree shall be awarded in the subject/discipline of the Faculty in which he/she has applied/registered for Ph.D. work. Further, if the Research Supervisor requires, a co-supervisor from another discipline (i.e., the subject chosen by the candidate at his/her Master's Degree) may be taken.

Note: Separate Sanskrit-aptitude test will be conducted for students under this inter-disciplinary category.

d) If the candidate wants to pursue the Ph.D. Degree in the subject/ discipline other than the one which he/she has chosen for P.G. Degree, then a special Board comprising of the subject experts of both or multiple discipline shall examine the proposal under the chairmanship of the Dean of concerned faculty. Further, the Degree shall be awarded in the subject/ discipline of the faculty in which the research scholar will be registered.

(VI) Allocation of Research Supervisor:

Only full time regular, permanent teacher of the University Department or its affiliated colleges can act as Research supervisor.

A professor with at least five research publications in referred journal can guide Eight (08)

Ph. D. Scholars at any given time.

An associate professor with Ph. D. Degree and at least two research publication in referred journal can guide six (06) Ph. D. Scholars at any given time and

An assistant professor with Ph. D. Degree and at least two research publication published in referred journal can guide (04) Ph. D. Scholars at any given time.

The allocation committee shall consist of:

a) University -

- i) Dean of the faculty (Chairman)
- ii) Director (Research)
- iii) Two subject experts (Nominated by VC)
- iv) Reservation category nominee. (Nominated by VC)

b) Research Centre's at affiliated colleges -

- i) Principal/his nominee (Chairman)
- ii) BOS Member nominated by VC
- iii) Two subject experts (Nominated by VC)
- iv) Reservation category nominee. (Nominated by VC)

c) Recognized Research Centre's -

- i) Director/his nominee (Chairman)
- ii) Dean of the concerned faculty.
- iii) Director Research
- iv) Head of the concerned department.
- v) Two subject experts (Nominated by VC)
- vi) Reservation category nominee. (Nominated by VC)

(VII) Course Work:

The credit assigned to the Ph. D. course work shall be minimum 08 Credits and a maximum of 16 Credits. A minimum of 04 Credits shall be assigned to one or more courses on Research Methodology which would cover areas such as quantitative methods, computer applications, research ethics and review of published research in the relevant field training, field work etc. other courses shall be advanced level courses, preparing the students for Ph. D. Degree.

All courses prescribed for Ph. D. course work shall be in conformity with the credit hour institutional requirement and shall specify content, instructional and assessment method, and they shall be duly approved by the authorized academic bodies.

All candidates admitted to the Ph. D. program shall be required to complete the course work prescribed by the department during the initial one or two semesters. The candidate should complete the course work within 2 years after provisional admission. Candidates already holding M. Phil. Degree may be exempted from the Ph. D. course work provided the course work is equivalent with the course work of Kavikulaguru Kalidas Sanskrit University. The equivalence certificate is required to be obtained from concerned Dean of the faculty.

In case of Interdisciplinary topic, the nature of course work will be decided by the supervisor in consultation with the concerned Dean. Course work by reading of suggested material/assignment/project work/field work/publication of research article in referred journal/conducting survey/participation in workshops/summer schools etc., could be designed by the supervisor, with equal credits to that of regular course work.

The M.Phil. students who have been exempted from course work, are required to complete the work assigned to them in place of coursework.

The candidates, having Ph.D./D.Phil./D.Sc./D.lit. degrees are exempted from the course work. However, they are required to complete the reading work/project/field work or any such assignment given by the supervisor to fulfill the partial requirement of the course work. All the candidates who have availed the exemption shall be given a certificate of completion of course work after completion of their assigned work.

Ph. D. scholar has to obtain a minimum 55 % marks or equivalent grade in the UGC 7-point scale (or an equivalent grade/ CGPA in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) in the course work in order to be eligible to continue in the program and submit the thesis.

(VIII)

a) **Registration:**

1.)The admitted Ph. D. research students who qualify the course exam of University shall prepare their synopsis under the guidance of their supervisor and submit it in 05 copies along with registration form and prescribe fee to the Ph. D. Cell. After receipt of application forms with copies of synopsis the Ph. D. Cell shall conduct the meeting of Doctoral Research committee (DRC) for each discipline separately for approval of synopsis of students by respective Doctoral Research committee (DRC). After approval from the Doctoral Research committee (DRC) the registration to the Ph. D. Students shall be given accordingly.

2.)The research scholar may be permitted to go for any change in the title registered for research within one year of his/her registration in such cases the research scholar should forward the application through the supervisor to the Dean of the concerned faculty and final approval can be obtained from the concerned DRC.

b) **Deregistration of Ph. D. Student:**

The name of the candidate shall stand automatically removed from the rolls of the University if he/she ;

- (i) Fails to submit his/her thesis within six years of the date of his/her initial admission to the Ph.D. Programme, the DRC on the recommendations of the concerned Centre/Department may, however, subsequently accept the request of a candidate whose name has been removed from the rolls of the University under sub-clause (i) above, to get re-enrolled and become eligible for submission of his/her thesis, provided that he/she submits his/her thesis within one year from the date of his/her re-enrollment.
- (ii) Join any other course of study; or
- (iii) Appear in any other examination other than those prescribed by the Department/Centre concerned without the prior permission of the DRC.

Break through Deregistration

In case of break from Ph. D. work on the ground of health or foreign visit or due to any other appropriate reason by the Ph. D. registered Student, the process of deregistration should be followed in consultation with guide and dean.

Period of deregistration (break) of research scholar should be excluded from total period of research and again reregistration is allowed to the students for continuity of research work after paying re-registration fee by the student to the University.

(IX) Withdrawal of Recognition as research Guide:

- 1) Recognition as guide for Post-graduate teaching/research shall stand withdrawn when the person is found for moral turpitude, has become insane and stands so declared by a competent court, has become undercharged and insolvent and so declared by a competent court, or has been physically unfit and incapable for discharging functions due to protracted illness or physical disability.
- 2)
 - a) Recognition for Post-graduate teaching/research shall stand withdrawn in case his approval as teacher in a College or Recognized Institution is withdrawn by the University.
 - b) Recognition for Post-graduate teaching/research shall be withdrawn if it is found that the teacher has submitted false or fabricated information/documents for recognition.
 - c) Recognition for Post-graduate teaching/research shall be withdrawn in case the teacher has committed any misconduct and has been inflicted with a major penalty for the misconduct having been duly proved. The recognition for Post-graduate teaching/research under the previous Directions shall be withdrawn only after due and sufficient opportunity is provided to such a teacher to show cause as to why such recognition should not be withdrawn. The decision of the Board of University Teaching and Research thereon shall be final.

(X) Research Advisory Committee:

There shall be research advisory committee or an equivalent body in the institution for each Ph. D. Scholar. The research supervisor of the scholar shall be the convener of this committee. The committee shall have the following responsibilities.

- a) To review the research proposal.
- b) To guide the research scholar to develop the study design and methodology of research.

- c) To periodically review and assist in the progress of the research work of the research scholar.
- (i) A research scholar shall appear before Research Advisory Committee once in six months to make a presentation of the progress of his/her work for evaluation and further guidance. The six-monthly progress reports shall be submitted by the Research Advisory Committee to the institution with a copy to research scholar.

In case the progress of research scholar is unsatisfactory the Research Advisory Committee shall record the reasons for the same and suggest corrective measures. If the research scholar fails to implement these corrective measures, the Research Advisory Committee may recommend to the institution with specific reason for cancellation of the registration of the research scholar.

(XI) Pre- Ph. D. Presentation:

Prior to submission of thesis, the scholar shall make a presentation of draft thesis in the department before the Research Advisory Committee of the institution concerned which shall also be open to all faculty members and other research scholars. The suggestions and recommendation obtained by them may be incorporated in the thesis in consultation with Research advisory committee.

(XII) Research paper in conference and Journal:

Ph. D. scholar must have published at least one (1) research paper in referred journal (enlisted by the UGC and or recognized by the University. and make two paper presentations in conference/ Seminar before submission of thesis for adjudication and produce evidence for the same in the form of presentation of certificates or reprints. The research paper published in journal or presented in conference/seminar must be co-authored by supervisor.

(XIII) Antiplagiarism:

Academic council should evolve mechanism by forming a committee to detect plagiarism by software while submitting the thesis for evaluation in Ph. D. Cell, the research scholar shall give an undertaking and certificate from research supervisor about originality of research work after due approval regarding plagiarism by the committee. Only such thesis is allowed to be submitted for evaluation.

(XIV) Research period:

The research scholar admitted for Ph.D. Admission will be on provisional basis is expected to complete his course work in one year and after the completion of the course work he/she should complete his research work within five years from the date of registration but he/ she cannot submit thesis before completion of **three years** of time from provisional admission. However, the research scholar cannot submit the thesis before 2 years after the completion of course work.

If the candidate fails to submit thesis, in 6 years from the date of provisional admission his/her registration will be cancelled. Such candidate can seek re-registration. The entire process of registration etc., will be as per the rules prevailing and applicable at that time.

(XV) Thesis Submission:

Note: The research student should note the following points:

1. The research student shall prepare summary of his/her thesis in Sanskrit (in one tenth pages of the total number of pages of the thesis) and attach it in the beginning of the thesis.
The medium of thesis should be Sanskrit by default. In case the demand of the subject/topic requires medium of the thesis other than Sanskrit, then the Dean of the concerned faculty may permit the medium other than Sanskrit after the approval of Vice-Chancellor.
2. The thesis should be in minimum 200 pages and typed using Unicode font.
3. The research student should submit five copies of the summary of the thesis to the university six months before the actual submission, so that the process of appointing adjudicators can be made early.
4. The research student should quote from the original texts of concerned language.
5. The research student should take proper care of the language corrections. He/she should get it done by any competent person, if required.

After complying with all the necessary procedure for submission, the candidate will submit the thesis in 05 copies to the Ph.D. Cell of the K.K.Sanskrit University. The copies of thesis submitted by the candidate will remain with the university finally.

The thesis should be unpublished and should be either type-written in Unicode font computer-printed. The thesis in book form will not be accepted for valuation.

No thesis will be accepted for valuation, unless all the fees due from the candidate are paid in totality.

The thesis should be submitted with the following declaration duly signed by the candidate.

"I state under oath that this research work is undertaken by me. It is the outcome of my personal research efforts and abilities. I have not plagiarized portion or portions from any other similar research work or books in any form. All the portions quoted from others' text are duly acknowledged. I have not submitted this thesis to any other University for award of Ph.D. Degree or similar Degree."

(XVI) The Appointment of Examiners 34(F) of Act 1997:

Summary shall then be forwarded by the Ph. D. Cell to the respective BoS in meeting to get names of Examiners or names of Examiners given by the BoS members. The name of the examiners obtained for the board of studies will be short listed by dean of the faculty and supervisor and same is placed before Hon'ble VC for selection of panel of examiners and the Hon'ble VC shall appoint three examiners to evaluate the thesis.

(XVII) Evaluation

After the Hon'ble VC has approved the panel of examiners, the Ph.D. Cell shall invite the first two examiners on the approved panel to examine the thesis. When an examiner accepts the invitation and the candidate has submitted the thesis, the Ph. D. Cell shall forward the thesis to the examiner within a week from the date of receipt of acceptance letter or the submission of thesis whichever is later. If an examiner does not accept the invitation within 30 days from the date of dispatch of the invitation letter, invitation shall be sent to the next examiner on the panel. Changing the examiner will be the sole discretion of the university and candidate will have no say in this matter. Any move in this matter by the candidate will compel the university to cancel the registration and stop the valuation process and treat the matter as finally cancelled. No refund will be given in the event of cancellation.

(XVIII) Result Pattern: -

After the valuation, there can be following possibilities-

Particulars	Result
A) Both the examiners approve the research work	- Thesis to be accepted.
B) Both the examiners reject the research work	- Thesis to be rejected.
C) One examiner approves the research work and the research work the second examiner rejects (Final Result-Best of the three)	- Referred to third examiner.
D) One examiner approves and second examiner recommends revision. (Final Result-Best of three)	- Referred to third examiner.
E) One examiner recommends rejection and second recommends revision	- Thesis to be rejected.
F) Both the examiners recommend revision	- Thesis to be sent for revision to research scholar. The student will be given a period of six months for revision. Provided that Academic council may give an additional period of six months for revision on recommendation of DRC. The revised thesis be revalued by the original examiner(s) unless one of them is, or both of them are unable to act as such, in which case another examiner(s) may be appointed. The result of thesis will be treated considering clause A to E of above. If the student fails to submit the revised thesis in the stipulated period, then the thesis shall be treated as rejected. In no case thesis can be permitted to be revised more than once.

The thesis above at **A** will stand accepted for the award of Ph.D. degree. The thesis at **C & D** shall be referred to the third examiner in the panel. If the third examiner recommends acceptance; the thesis will stand approved for Ph.D. Degree. After obtaining any of the above results it will be placed before BoE. for its approval. Unless the result is approved by the BoE. it will not be treated as final. The BoE shall have the right to inquire into any of the reported malpractices before granting approval to the recommendations. If BoE finds substance in the allegation through the inquiry committee, it can send the thesis to remaining different examiners in the panel. The BoE shall have no right to change the result of the thesis.

(XIX) Viva-Voce:

- Viva-Voce examination shall be conducted by Ph.D. cell in the university campus. Dean of the faculty shall be the chairman of viva-voce examination and will be conducted by the Research Supervisor and at least one of the two external examiners and shall be

open to the members of Research Advisory Committee, All faculty members of the department and other research scholars.

- The Viva-Voce of research scholar shall be conducted only if the evaluation report(s) of the external examiner(s) is /are satisfactory and include specific recommendation for conducting the Viva-Voce examination.

(XX) The University shall develop appropriate methods so as to complete the entire process of evaluation of Ph. D. thesis within period of six months from the date of submission of the thesis.

(XXI) Academic, Administrative and infrastructure requirement to be fulfilled by colleges for getting recognition to offer Ph. D. program only if they satisfy the availability of eligible research supervisor, required infrastructure and supporting administrative and research promotion facilities can be considered as research center.

(XXII) Award of Ph. D. Degree prior to notification of these Regulations:

Award of degrees to candidates registered for Ph. D. program on or after July, 11, 2009 till the date of implementation of UGC regulations 2016 shall be governed by the provision of the UGC Regulation 2009.

Depository with INFLIBNET:

After completion of evaluation process and before the announcement of the award of Ph. D. Degree the institute shall submit soft copy of the Ph. D. thesis to the INFLIBNET for hosting the same so as to make it accessible to all institutions.

Repeal

All disputes regarding any rule or its interpretation may be brought to the notice of the Vice-Chancellor for a solution. His decision will be final.
