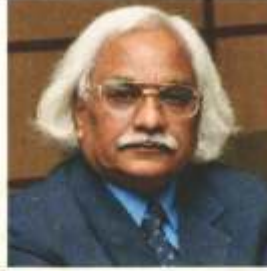

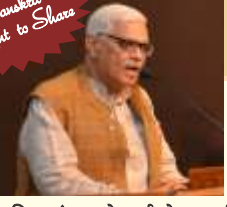

अस्मिन् संस्कृतमेव कार्यक्रमे आदरणीयाः अभ्यागतवर्षाः! यथायथम् सर्वेभ्योऽपि भवद्भिः अभिवादनानि। अहम् भवद्भिः आहूतः सन् महान्तं हर्षं गौरवं चापि अनुभवामि। अयं विश्वविद्यालयः सर्वस्यापि मध्यदेशस्य अलंकारभूतः अस्ति। भारतस्य सारभूता भाषा संस्कृतभाषा, संस्कृतवाङ्मयस्य च सारभूतं तस्य साहित्यं, संस्कृतसाहित्यस्य च सारभूतः वर्तते कविकालिदासः। यस्य नाम अपि जिह्वां पवित्रीकरोति यस्य काव्यस्य मर्मं महारसिकैः अपि न ज्ञातम्। यथा कथयति मल्लिनाथः—

कालिदासगिरां सारं कालिदासः सरस्वती।

चतुर्मुखोऽथवा ब्रह्मा विदुः, नान्ये तु मादृशाः॥

तस्य कविकुलगुरोः नाम्ना प्रथितेऽस्मिन् विश्वविद्यालये अहमागत्य आत्मानं धन्यम् अनुभवामि। माम् आहूतवद्भिः च महतीं कृतज्ञतां व्यञ्जयामि।

हर्षप्रकर्षस्यायम् विषयः यद् सर्वस्मिन् अपि देशे अयं वर्तमानः सप्ताहः संस्कृतसप्ताहत्वेन मान्यते। श्रावणीपूर्णिमायां दिनं संस्कृतदिनं तस्मादनन्तरो सप्ताहः संस्कृतसप्ताहः। संस्कृतस्य संस्कृतजनेषु अथ च सामान्यजनेषु, सर्वत्र संस्कृतस्य व्याप्तिं सुनिश्चेतुं इदं सप्ताहाचरणं महान् कश्चित् अवसरः। संस्कृतभाषा अनेकसहस्रवर्षेभ्यः पूर्वं भारतस्य जनभाषा आसीत्। शनैः शनैः प्राकृतभाषाणां समुदयः संजातः। संस्कृतेन प्रत्येकयुगे जनभाषाणां साहाय्यं पोषणं च कृतम्। यदा संस्कृतं जनभाषा न आसीत् तदा अपि संस्कृतस्य माहात्म्यं अल्पतां न गतम्। संस्कृतं सदैव भारतीय-ज्ञानविज्ञानस्य, भारतदेशस्य संपर्कसूत्रस्य, विदुषां शास्त्रार्थस्य च भाषा अतिष्ठत्। अनेकानि युगानि व्यतीतानि संस्कृतस्य महत्त्वं तु तथैव अस्ति। अनेकाः प्राकृत-पालि-आदि-भाषाः समासाः परन्तु संस्कृतं सहस्रवर्षाणि अद्यापि च भारते महत्त्वमावधत्ति। तत्र किं कारणम्? तत्र कारणं संस्कृतस्य भारतीयानां कृते महती उपयोगिता। एषा उपयोगिता केवलं धर्म-सम्प्रदायमात्रसीमिता नास्ति। अपितु भारते यत्किञ्चिद् अपि आत्मीयं मौलिकं वा विद्यते तस्य सर्वस्यापि संग्रहः सुरक्षणं च संस्कृते निहितं वर्तते। भारतस्य प्राचीनः इतिहासः, भारतस्य प्राचीना चिन्तनपद्धतिः, प्राचीना जीवनपद्धतिः, भारतीयानां जातीयत्वं, किं बहुना— भारतवर्षनिवासिनां सर्वेषामपि मनुष्याणां अभिज्ञानं यदि वयमिच्छामः ज्ञातुं तर्हि संस्कृतमेव शरणम्।

संस्कृतस्य ज्ञानं न केवलं प्राचीनतायां सम्यग् अवबोधार्थम् आवश्यकम् अपितु आधुनिकभारतीयानाम् एकसूत्रीकरणार्थमपि संस्कृतं बहु आवश्यकम्। अस्माकं देशः विभिन्नानां संस्कृतीनां, जातीनां, भाषाणां, धर्माणां च देशः संस्कृतं विविधतामयं इदं देशं एकतायां सूत्रे सम्बन्धयति। तत्र वर्तते कारणद्वयं— अस्माकं प्रान्तीयभाषासु सन्ति विविधताः— परन्तु सर्वत्र संस्कृतस्य बहवः शब्दाः अनुस्यूताः सन्ति। एतेन सर्वभाषाभाषिणां मध्ये काचित् एकता अनुभूयते। सा च एकता अस्माकं राष्ट्रस्य एकतायै अत्यन्तमेव आवश्यकम्। द्वितीयं कारणम् अस्ति— संस्कृतशास्त्रैः वाङ्मयैः च प्रवाहिता या ज्ञानसंस्कृतिः विद्यते सा संस्कृतिः नाडीषु रक्तवत् प्रवहन्ती सर्वत्रापि देशे प्रायः समाना एव दृश्यते। अनया संस्कृताश्रितायां संस्कृत्या हिमालयतः सागरपर्यन्तस्य भूभागस्य राष्ट्रियकरणम् विहितम्। यथा उक्तं केनचित्—

आहिमात्रिसमुद्रान्तं मनुजानां समन्वयं ।

चक्रे या भारती तस्यै नमोवाकं प्रशास्महे॥

संस्कृतं अस्माकं देशस्य एकीकरणे यानि तत्त्वानि विद्यन्ते तेषु अन्यतमम्। यदि एतत् न स्यात् तर्हि समस्तः अपि भारते देशः विशीर्णं भवेत्। हिन्दीक्षेत्रस्य तुलसीदासादिकवयः भवेयुः, मध्यदेशस्य ज्ञानेश्वरादयः स्युः, आन्ध्रदेशस्य कवयः पोटन्ना-आदयः सन्तु, सुदूरक्षेत्रस्य पूतानम्-प्रभृतयो वा विद्वांसः भवन्तु—संस्कृतस्य सम्यक् ज्ञानाद् विना एतेषां विदुषां विचाराणाम् अवबोधः दुष्करः। तत्र कारणम्— एते कवयः संस्कृतेन प्रवाहितं संस्कृतम् एव बहन्तः आसन् अतः संस्कृताद् विना एतेषां भाव-अधिगमः असम्भवः।

एवं प्रकारेण संस्कृतभाषा अस्मान् निजस्वरूपस्य निदर्शनं कारयति। अस्माकं महामहिमशालिनां पूर्वजानां परिचयं कारयित्वा अस्माकं अग्रे महान्तम् आदर्शम् उपस्थापयति— तेषाम् आदर्शानाम् उपलब्धये अस्मान् प्रेरयति— तस्य मार्गं च निदर्शयति। एवं प्रकारेण अस्मान् निरन्तरं अग्रे सारयति पतनात् च रक्षति। यथा वर्तते प्रार्थना—

अग्रे, नय सुपथा राये अस्मान् विश्वानि देव वयुनानि विद्वान्।

यथा च मनुः—

येनास्य पितरो याताः येन याताः पितामहाः।

तेन यायात् सतां मार्गं तेन गच्छन्न रिष्यति॥

अथ च संस्कृतं न केवलं बाह्यस्वरूपस्य ज्ञानाय अपितु अन्तःस्वरूपस्य प्रत्यभिज्ञानाय अपि नितराम् आवश्यकम्। किं बहुना, भारतीयानां आधिभौतिक-आधिदैविक-आध्यात्मिक-हिताय संस्कृतम् अत्यन्तम् अनिवार्यम् एव।

संस्कृतस्य एतावतीं महत्तां समवलोक्य अस्माकं पूर्वजैः सहस्रवर्षाणि संस्कृतस्य निरन्तरं सुरक्षा कृता येन अस्यां भाषायां लिखितानि वस्तूनि सुरक्षितानि स्युः। सहस्रवर्षाणाम् अस्माकं इतिहासः संस्कृतस्य सुरक्षायै क्रियमाणानां यत्नानाम् अपि इतिहासः वर्तते। पाणिनेः व्याकरणाद् अनन्तरम् अपि बहूनि व्याकरणानि लिखितानि यथा कातन्त्रव्याकरणं—चान्द्रव्याकरणं—भोजव्याकरणं—हेमचन्द्रव्याकरणम्। अनेन स्पष्टं भवति यत् भारतीयः संस्कृतस्य युगानुकूलशिक्षणपद्धतये अनारतं यत् कुर्वन्तः आसन्। अनेन महता यत्नेन भारतीयाः सफलाः आसन् स्वकीयभाषायाः सुरक्षायाम्। भाषिकसुरक्षायै व्याकरणस्य सम्यक् अध्ययनं आवश्यकम्। तदर्थं शास्त्रेषु ऐहलौकिक-पारलौकिकाः उभयथा अपि लाभा दर्शिताः, यथा—

यश्च व्याकुरुते वाचं यश्च मीमांसतेऽध्वरम्।

तावुभौ पुण्यकर्माणीं पङ्क्तिपावनपावनौ॥ इत्यादि

भाषायाः सुरक्षणेन भारतीयानां सम्पूर्णापि संस्कृतिः सुरक्षिता अतिष्ठत्।

संस्कृतभाषा न केवलं भारतस्य कृते अपितु सम्पूर्णस्यापि भारोपीयजनानां तेषां भाषाणां सम्यक् अध्ययनार्थं आवश्यकम्। जानन्ति एव भाषाविदः यद् भारतस्य यूरोपीयदेशानां मध्ये एकात्मतायाः निदर्शनं मूलभारोपीयभाषा संस्कृतस्य एव आधारेण पुनर्निर्मिता। संस्कृतस्य अध्ययनेन एव रहस्यम् एतद् उद्घाटितं यत् सर्वेऽपि भारोपीयजनाः एकेन एव केनचित् मनुष्यपरिवारेण सम्बद्धाः सन्ति। तत्र कारणत्रयं विद्यते— संस्कृतभाषायाः— १. प्राचीनता, २. अविच्छिन्नता, ३. विपुलता च।

प्राचीनतायाः कारणात् संस्कृतभाषायां भूयस्यः व्याकरणिक-कोटयः सन्ति। तस्मात् कारणात् एषा भाषा बहुस्तरीया (Multi-layered) भाषा वर्तते। एतस्याः शिक्षणेन मस्तिष्के विविधाः भाषिकसंकायाः (faculties) स्वतः निर्मायन्ते येन मस्तिष्कं भूयसा कार्यरतं भवति। अनेकेषां अन्येषां शास्त्राणां अध्ययनार्थं मार्गः प्रशस्तः भवति।

भारतं नवीनसहस्राब्दे स्वकीयमहिमनि विश्वपटले नितरां समुदेति। अद्युना भारताय संस्कृतस्य आवश्यकता पूर्वभ्यः युगेभ्यः अपि अधिका वर्तते। साम्प्रतं भारतीयजनानां परस्परसंबन्धनाय दृढतरस्य कस्यचित् सूत्रस्य आवश्यकता वर्तते। तत् सूत्रं वर्तते संस्कृतम्।

महत्तः हर्षस्य अयं विषयः यत् आधुनिककाले संस्कृतक्षेत्रे संभाषण-आन्दोलनं अखिलभारतस्तरे दृश्यते। अनेन संस्कृतस्य महान् लाभः। संस्कृतस्य जनसामान्ये पुनः आनयनाय अयं एव मार्गः केवलम्। संस्कृतस्य मन्दातायाः कारणं गते काले इदं यत् संस्कृतस्य सामान्यजनेषु प्रसारः अल्पः अभवत्। तत्र च कारणं— संस्कृतस्य दैनन्दिनजीवने अभ्यासाभावः। यस्याः भाषायाः वयं श्रवणं न कुर्मः सा भाषा अस्माकं कृते कठिना प्रतीयते। सम्भाषणस्य अनभ्यासात्, श्रवणस्य च अभावात् अद्यत्वे संस्कृतभाषा कठिना इव प्रतीयते। कठिनाकारणं संस्कृताद् भयं भवति। तद् भयं जनसामान्यस्य तु अस्ति एव संस्कृतच्छात्रान् अपि कदाचित् संस्कृताध्यापकान् अपि तद् भयं बाधते।

एतां कठिनताम् अपाकर्तुं किं करणीयम्? एषा कठिनता सम्भाषणस्य अभावात् उत्पन्ना। अतः एतस्याः दूरीकरणं सम्भाषणस्य अभ्यासेन एव कर्तुं शक्यते। यदा वयं कस्याः अपि भाषायाः सम्भाषणं कुर्मः तदा अस्माकं अनेकानि इन्द्रियाणि तस्मिन् कार्ये संलग्नानि भवन्ति— चिन्तने मस्तिष्कं, उच्चारणे उच्चारणस्थानानि, श्रवणे कर्णा इत्यादि। अतः तस्याः भाषायाः महान् अभ्यासः भवति। सम्भाषणेन भाषायाः व्याकरणम् अनायासम् एव बुद्धिगतं भवति। व्याकरणशिक्षणस्य सरलः मार्गः सम्भाषणम्। सम्भाषणेन छात्रेषु महान् कश्चन आत्मविश्वासः प्रकटीभवति यदा ते आत्मनः सहस्रवर्षपूर्वा स्वकीय-संस्कृतेः भाषां, स्वीय-पूर्वजानां भाषां— संस्कृतभाषाम् स्वयं वक्तुं समर्थाः भवन्ति। सः च आत्मविश्वासः संस्कृतच्छात्रेषु हीनभावनां दूरीकरोति, या हीनभावना दौर्भाग्येण संस्कृतक्षेत्रे दरीदृश्यते।

प्रमोदस्य इदं स्थानं यत् कविकुलगुरुकालिदासविश्वविद्यालये समायोज्यमानेऽस्मिन् कार्यक्रमे संस्कृतसंवर्धनस्य सर्वविधोऽपि उपायः अनुष्ठीयते। अहं वैयक्तिकरूपेण कार्यक्रमेषु एतेषु रुचिं दधानः एतेषां सर्वथा साफल्यस्य कामनां करोमि आयोजकेभ्यश्च वर्षापानानि वितरामि।

पुनरेकवारं माम् अत्र आहूतवद्भिः संस्कृतबन्धुभ्यः नितरां आभारभरं अभिव्यञ्जयन् विरमामि।

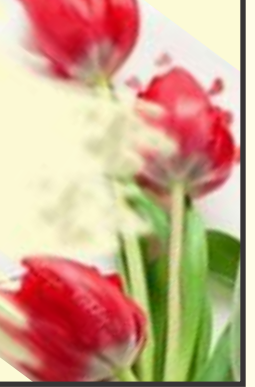

■ 'The Hitavada' holds 13th College Principals' Conclave on the topic 'Aa No Bhadrha Kratavo Yantu Vishwataha'

WHEN open minds meet, they discuss things threadbare, pick up the common threads and then give a definite direction to others so that they achieve the common goal of serving the interest of larger society and nation and the world.

This, precisely, is what happened at the 13th College Principals' Conclave organised by 'The Hitavada' on the topic 'Aa No Bhadrha Kratavo Yantu Vishwataha' (May noble thoughts come to us from all universe), on Sunday.

Prof Dr Shrinivasa Varakhedi, Vice-Chancellor of Kavikulaguru Kalidas Sanskrit University (KKSU), and Prof Dr Ashish

Patarkar, Vice-Chancellor of Maharashtra Animal and Fisheries Sciences University (MAFSU), were the eminent speakers who discussed the theme and steered the collective thinking towards the common goal of transforming education system into a system of higher learning.

A person with an open mind can accept noble thoughts coming from all directions. Of course, to accept only the noble thoughts and reject ignoble ones, one has to have an understanding

of one's duties.

However, the modern-day education system teaches rights and not duties. In this system, the institutions have become factories producing graduates saleable in market. To change the scenario, need is to blend the values of the ancient system of 'Gurukul' with concepts of modern education. To achieve that goal, educational institutions will have to be transformed into centres of higher learning where noble thoughts coming

from all directions are accepted with openness.

Prof Dr Varakhedi said that divorcing Sanskrit language from modern-day pursuits of knowledge had resulted in various problems related to learning process. For, he said, a rich treasure-trove of knowledge and wisdom was available in Sanskrit. "To gain access to that, we need to liberate our mind from negative thinking that anything Indian is inferior. Once we do that, we can realise the power of openness

that can help us accept all the noble thoughts. It can help us build a peaceful world," he said.

Prof Dr Patarkar stressed upon need for the teachers and students both to open their minds to ancient wisdom and new ideas both. In the era when Google was being treated as a 'Guru', information was exploding into lives of people every minute.

"IF WE want to create a nice, good society, we need to inculcate sense of duty. Without sense of duty, we cannot create a beautiful family, a peaceful society, and a powerful nation," said Prof Dr Shrinivasa Varakhedi, Vice-Chancellor of Kavikulaguru Kalidas Sanskrit University (KKSU).

Speaking at the 13th Principals' Conclave organised by 'The Hitavada' on Sunday, Dr Varakhedi explained that theme 'Aa no bhadrha kratavo yantu vishwataha'. The Sanskrit scholar said that the word 'Kratavo' could be explained in different ways. To understand it better, one needed to understand the concept of 'Karma'. "Karma is nothing but duty. In life, all relations including familial and friendly come with duties towards one another," he said. "When I came into

existence, I came with some obligations without which my life is not complete," he added.

Dr Varakhedi spoke of the difference between the Western and the Indian minds. "The Western mind thinks of everything from rights perspective, that is, the world is meant for me to enjoy. Hence, protection of individual rights from attack of others is important there," he explained. Whereas, he elaborated, the Indian mind thought that one was part of the whole. "As I am part of the whole, the rest does not belong to me and hence I cannot take everything for granted. Our concept of joy is bound to duties," he observed.

Quoting from Sanskrit scriptures and scholars, Dr Varakhedi observed that all noble acts (Sadachar) and thoughts (Sadvichar) should result in larger public interest. Gurukul system imparted good conduct among students and Guru also learned from students. Hence, in olden days, the Gurukuls

were called centres of higher learning and not higher education. "We need to revisit the philosophy of education," he stressed.

Lamenting that present-day educational institutions had become factories that produced graduates saleable in the market, the acclaimed academician and thinker said that focus in this system was on rigid frame-work. "The purpose of education is to liberate one from all clutches. When mind is not liberated, it cannot accept thoughts openly. Sadly, education today is creating valves, buildings of pre-occupations. As a result, our minds are unable to see the best in the world. This is in sharp contrast to Indian tradition which is very rich in diversity, and yet harmonious. This underlines the need to go back to the principle of 'Aa no bhadrha kratavo yantu vishwataha' in education," he concluded.
